<b>Peter Howson in focus: Holocaust Crowd Scene, 2011</b>	14 June to 14 July	A new initiative focussing in depth to explore the many layers of engagement generated by this contemporary reflection.
<b>Laura Knight in focus: Nuremberg Trials, 1946</b>	26 July to 1 September	Exploring both her appointment as an official War Artist to record this historically important moment and the significance of the art produced.
<b>Sheer Verve: The Women's International Art Club</b>	13 September to 15 December	The Women's International Art Club was founded in Paris in 1898 as an exhibition platform and networking forum for women artists. This loan exhibition celebrates its 125th anniversary with artists including Delaunay, Colquhoun, Hepworth, John, Moss and Rego.
